

Length of Economic Expansions: Current vs. Previous Six Longest






What will kill this expansion?

- Most likely, high interest rates as Fed responded to rising inflation. Just like the late 1950s, late 1960s, late 1980s. But already see central banks around the world slow down in hikes.
- Energy/Oil shock inflation In 1974 caused a recession as higher prices eroded purchasing power.
- Collapse of dot.com investment boom of late 1990s, together with stock market crash.
- Collapse of housing and excess leverage that led up to 2008-09 financial crisis.
- Or something new...federal shut down: Q1 2019 GDP forecasts = 0% and job losses on the horizon.




Total U.S. Goods Producing vs Service Providing BLS Employment: Jan 2008 to Dec 2018






U.S Labor Force Participation Rates Who is Working...?







Differences Between Genders Alcohol Past 30 Days


US Demographics Legal Drinking Age Adults (21+ / LDA)








U.S. Population by Age 2017





Hispanic Share of U.S. Census Population 2010 to 2017






Hispanic Preferences Alcohol Past 30 Days






Imports and Mexico Share of Volume 1990 to 2018






Count of Brewers and Craft Share of Volume 2000 to 2018






Beer Segment Shares Growing High-End Beyond 40 Share






Total U.S. Ethanol Per Capita 2010 to 2017










Texas vs Colorado

Total Per Capita Ethanol Consumption




Growth in ABV for Beer and Liquor 2010 vs 2017






ABV by Beer Segment 2017







BLS at Home (Off Premise) Consumer Price Index Jan 2008 to Dec 2018









U.S. BLS: Establishment Counts







Growth in Alcohol Beverage Wholesalers 2010 to 2018


